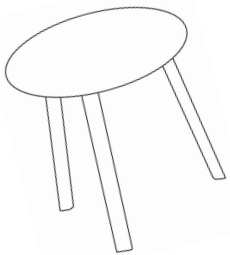

NEIGHBORHOOD YARD SALE



"Hello Pensacola Park Neighborhood Residents! My name is Greg Scarboro and I have lived on Suburban Ct. the past 17 years. Each year, on Suburban, we try to have an entire street yard sale but the pandemic put a kink in that. So I was thinking instead of a single street sale, why not an ENTIRE Pensacola Park Neighborhood sale! What I am proposing is that we aim for the second weekend in August (this year that falls on August 13th and 14th).

The reasoning you ask? Most of the yard sales are earlier in the summer and we will have less competition. In August there is less chance of rain. UK starts back August 23rd, dorm residents move the weekend before, students who rent apartments move in earlier and are looking for furniture, dishes, nic nacs, bargains.

Why two days? If it rains Friday u got Saturday if it rains Saturday u got Friday if it rains both days we are just unlucky!! If you want to participate Friday, good! If you want to participate Saturday, good! If you want to participate both days, Great!! If it's successful then we do this the same second weekend every year! Everyone will know the date in advance. You can plan around it accordingly. There won't be any wondering when it is. Also we can use the same signage from year to year. Pensacola Park Neighborhood Association will get signs for each street captain to post a week before the sale. I am thinking a sign at the corner of Nicholasville and Suburban, Penmoken, Wabash, Lackawanna, and Goodrich and 2 each at the corner of Nicholasville and Rosemont Garden and Southland and Rosemont Garden. Now keep in mind, each individual household is responsible for their personal signage stating house number, time they are holding their garage sale, etc. posted wherever you like (not on stop signs). I would recommend posting your yard sale listing on craigslist, nextdoor, and facebook with pictures listing your items for sale and definitely stating your house is part of a larger neighborhood sale called Pensacola Park Neighborhood Sale.

Also if anyone owns or has an in on a printing or sign company where we can get a price break for the signage it would be appreciated.

LEARN TIPS AND TRICKS ON TAKING CARE OF YOUR TREES

Upcoming Neighborhood Grants/Awards/Memorials

- Lackawanna and Pensacola are set to receive street trees from a neighborhood grant. We are in the process of waiting on funds to be distributed, in which we can order trees for those who wrote us asking for a street tree. We need volunteers to plant trees, so please reach out if you would like to help plant some neighborhood trees.
- Penmoken Circle received some new “curbs” to help mitigate water around the circle thanks to our Councilwoman Hannah LeGris. While this has helped mitigate water, there are still some issues that are cropping up, that will need to be further evaluated, but it’s a step in the right direction. If you live in the circle, please make sure to send a thank you to CM Legris.
- Jake Gibbs Memorial site in our neighborhood is still set to be developed within Penmoken Circle. We have received our approval for grant money to plant a memorial /gathering site here with a plaque in his memory. We are just waiting on final city sign offs before proceeding with design implementation.
